Audio description is a narration service for people who are blind or have low vision. The audio describer provides an ongoing dialogue of visuals at live theater performances and events.

Participants Will Learn:

- How to articulate visual details effectively and in the moment.
- Tips for bringing audio description back to your organization as an accommodation.
- How to enhance the theater experience for the blind and visually impaired audience.

Participants Must:

- Pay attention to detail.
- Articulate quickly and clearly.
- Possess strong oral and written communication skills.
